HISTORY OF THE INSTITUTION

Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering (SVCE), a unit of Sri Venkateswara Educational and Health Trust (SVEHT) was inaugurated by the then Governor of Tamil Nadu, Honorable Shri S L Khurana. The inaugural function of the college complex at Nazarathpet took place on 8th April 1985. Formal academic classes were inaugurated by former Union Minister of Finance Honorable Shri C Subramanian on 19th August 1985.

The Gruhapravesam function of the new Campus at Pennalur, Sriperumbudur Taluk was held on 25th July 1991. The Campus houses a Vinayaka temple “SRI VIJAYA GANAPATHI ALAYAM”. The new Campus was inaugurated on 5th January 1992 by the then President of India, His Excellency Shri R Venkataraman.

A major objective of this Institution is to plan and implement a programme of education in Engineering and Allied Sciences in order to promote research, to disseminate knowledge and to foster cooperation and exchange of ideas between the academic community and industrial organizations and to develop entrepreneurship skills among students. It strives to achieve academic excellence along with the harmonious development of personality of students.

The Governing Council which is the Apex Body for the governance of the College is chaired by well-known industrialist and philanthropist Dr A C Muthiah, Chairman Emeritus, SPIC Ltd. Under his guidance, the College has progressed phenomenally. In the last thirty six years, there has been an all round development in infrastructure and research and academic activities.

Thirty two batches of students have graduated from the College. Many of them have completed their Masters Degree. Several of our Alumni have completed PhD and work in prestigious US, UK and Indian Universities. Many work in reputed companies like General Motors, Microsoft, Google, Paypal, E&Y, CISCO, GEC, Infosys, TCS, CTS, Accenture, Wipro, Hyundai, Ford, AMW, HCL, TVS and Hindustan Motors. A few are entrepreneurs.

The College is situated in an area of about 94 acres at Pennalur, Sriperumbudur Taluk with excellent infrastructural facilities that include instructional buildings, laboratories, workshops, faculty rooms, office, conference halls, dispensary, technology innovation centre, staff quarters, guest houses, open air auditorium, library, canteens, hostels, swimming pool, RO plant, solar water heater, laundry service, sewage treatment plant, solar power plant, rain water harvesting pond, gymnasium, multi-purpose auditorium for indoor sports and play grounds.

The College celebrated its decennium on 16th March 1996 and then Honorable Minister of State for Commerce Shri P Chidambaram presided over the function. The College conducted the Graduation Day for the first time on 10th January 2009 with eminent scientist ISRO Dr. Mylswamy Annadurai as the Guest of Honour. The College conducted the 12th Graduation Day. On 25th January 2020 with Mr Ramkumar Rammoorthy, Chairman and Managing Director, Cognizant India, As the chief guest.

The University Grants Commission conferred autonomous status upon our institution during may 2016.

GENERAL INFORMATION

STUDENT CONDUCT

Every student is required to observe disciplined and decorous behaviour both inside and outside the College campus and not to indulge in any activity which will tend to bring down the prestige of the College.

Students are expected to follow a dress code conforming to the professional attire.

Intimidation of freshers by senior students in any form inside or outside the Campus during or after College hours is strictly prohibited. Under the Governments' Education rules, the Principal has full power to take action against erring and defaulting students with fine, suspension or expulsion.

Every student shall, on admission, sign a Code of Conduct which he/she is expected to strictly adhere to during the entire course of his/her studies in the College. Every parent/guardian also signs a Code of Conduct vouching for his/her wards' conduct.

ACADEMIC HOURS

College will work for the stipulated contact hours as prescribed by the curriculum under regulation 2018 of SVCE during a semester for both UG and PG programmes.

ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

The students are expected to study throughout the semester. Tests are conducted and activity based assignments are given to monitor such continual study and progress.

SYSTEM OF EXAMINATION

Performance in each course of study shall be evaluated based on

- (i) Continuous Internal Assessment Tests throughout the semester and
- (ii) End Semester examination at the end of each semester.

PROCEDURE FOR AWARDING MARKS FOR INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

The regulations 2018 of SVCE for UG and PG are followed in awarding internal marks. For all theory (including project work) the continuous assessment shall be for a maximum of 50 marks. For the practical courses, the continuous assessment marks shall be for a maximum of 75 marks. The above continuous assessment marks shall be awarded as per the procedure given below:

(i) Theory Courses (Regulation 2018)

Three tests shall be conducted during the semester by the department concerned. The total marks obtained in three tests shall be proportionately reduced to 50 marks and rounded off to the nearest integer.

(ii) Practical Courses (Regulation 2018)

The criteria for arriving at the internal assessment marks of 75 are as follows:

- (A) Every practical exercise / experiment will be evaluated based on the performance and the maintenance of observation/record. 50 marks will be awarded for successful completion of all the prescribed experiments.
- (B) There will be one model practical examination which will carry a weightage of 25 marks.

EVALUATION OF PROJECT WORK (REGULATION 2018)

Project work may be allotted to a single student or to a group of students not exceeding three per group. In some special cases, four students may be grouped and the same has to be recommended by the project guide and approved by the Head of the Department.

The Head of the Department concerned shall constitute a review committee for project work for each branch of study. There shall be three reviews during the semester by the review committee. The student shall make presentation on the progress made by him / her before the committee. The total marks obtained in the three reviews shall be **reduced for 65 marks** and rounded to the nearest integer.

The project report shall be submitted as per the approved guidelines as given by **Board of Studies**. Same mark shall be awarded to every student within the project group for the project report. The viva-voce examination shall carry 35 marks. Marks are awarded to each student of the project group based on the individual performance in the viva-voce examination.

If a candidate fails to submit the project report on or before the specified deadline, he/she is deemed to have failed in the Project Work and shall re-enroll for the same in a subsequent semester.

PASSING REQUIREMENTS:

UG Regulations 2018

A student who secures not less than 50% of total marks prescribed for the course [Internal Assessment + End semester Examinations] with a minimum of 45% of the marks prescribed for the End semester Examination, shall be declared to have passed the course and acquired the relevant number of credits. This is applicable for both theory and practical courses (including project work).

PG Regulations 2018

A student who secures not less than 50% of total marks prescribed for the course [Internal Assessment + End semester Examinations] with a minimum of 50% of the marks prescribed for the end-semester Examination, shall be declared to have passed the course and acquired the relevant number of credits. This is applicable for both theory and practical courses (including project work).

The passing requirement for the courses which are assessed only through purely internal assessments (EEC courses except project work), is 50% of the internal assessment (continuous assessment) marks only.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPLETION OF THE SEMESTER (REGULATION 2018)

A student who has fulfilled the following conditions shall be deemed to have satisfied the attendance requirements for appearing for end semester examination of a particular course.

1. A candidate who has fulfilled the following conditions shall be deemed to have satisfied requirements for completion of a semester.

Ideally every student is expected to attend all classes and secure 100% attendance. However, in order to give provision for certain unavoidable reasons such as Medical / participation in sports, the student is expected to attend atleast 75% of the classes course wise taking into account the number of periods required for that course as specified in the curriculum.

Therefore, he/she shall Secure not than 75% (after rounding off to the nearest integer) of the classes course wise attendance.

- (i) He/she has earned not less than 75% of attendance on an average in all the courses in that semester put together
 - (ii). His / her progress has been satisfactory, and
 - (iii). His / her conduct has been satisfactory.
2. However, a candidate who secures overall attendance between 65% and 74% in the current semester due to medical reasons (prolonged hospitalization / accident / specific illness) / Participation in Sports events may be permitted to appear for the current semester examinations subject to the condition that the candidate shall submit the medical certificate / sports participation certificate attested by the Head of the Institution and also by paying the condonation fee.

3. A student shall normally be permitted to appear for End semester examination of the course if the student has satisfied the attendance requirements (Vide Clause 1-2) and has registered for examination in those courses of that semester by paying the prescribed fee.
4. Students who do not satisfy clause 1-2 and who secure less than 65% attendance in a course will not be permitted to write the End Semester Examination of that course. The student has to register and repeat this course in a subsequent semester when it is offered next. Students who failed to score 75% attendance in one-third of the registered courses in the current semester, they would not permitted to move for higher semester.
5. In the case of reappearance registration for a course, the attendance requirement as mentioned in Clauses 1-3 is not applicable. However, the student has to register for examination in that course by paying the prescribed fee.
6. A student who has already appeared for a course in a semester and passed the examination is not entitled to reappear in the same course for improvement of letter grades / marks.
7. For the purpose of calculation of attendance requirement for writing the end semester examinations by the students for every course, the following method shall be used:

$$\text{Percentage of Attendance} = \frac{\text{(Total number of periods attended in every course during the semester)}}{\text{(Total number of periods conducted in that semester for that particular course)}} \times 100$$

ATTENDANCE AND ASSESSMENT RECORD

Every teacher maintains an ATTENDANCE AND ASSESSMENT RECORD which consists of attendance marked in each lecture class or practical class or project work class, the test marks and the record of class work (topic covered) separately for each course.

This should be submitted to the Head of the Department periodically (at least three times in a semester) for checking the syllabus coverage and the records of test marks and attendance.

The Head of the Department will affix his/her signature and date after due verification. At the end of the semester, the record should be verified by the Principal who will keep this document in safe custody (for five years).

FACULTY ADVISOR

To help students plan their courses of study and to provide advice on the academic programme, each Department attaches twenty students to a teacher, who shall function as their Faculty Advisor throughout the period of study. Faculty Advisers shall advise their students and monitor the courses taken by them, check their attendance and progress, and counsel them periodically. They will also discuss with, or inform parents about the progress of students. They will apprise Heads of Departments and the Principal about performance and progress of their students.

A psychological counsellor is available in the campus to provide professional counselling for the students.

CLASS COMMITTEE

A class committee consists of teachers of the subjects concerned, student representatives, faculty advisors and a chairperson who is not teaching the class. its goal is to improve the teaching-learning process. There shall be not less than three class committee meetings in each semester.

PERSONALITY AND CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT

All students shall enroll, on admission, in any one of the personality and character development programmes (the NCC/NSS/NSO) and undergo training for stipulated hours and attend a camp. The training shall include classes on hygiene and health awareness and also training in first-aid.

National Cadet Corps (NCC) will conduct about 20 parades.

National Service Scheme (NSS) will carry out social service activities in and around the college.

National Sports Organization (NSO) will conduct sports, games, drills and physical exercises.

While the training activities will normally be during weekends, the camp will normally be during vacation period. Every student shall put in a stipulated attendance in the training and attend the camp compulsorily. The training and camp shall be completed during the first and second year of the programme.

INFRASTRUCTURE

LIBRARY AND BOOK BANK

Dr. A.C. Muthiah Central Library has more than 1,04,896 volumes of printed books and 1458 eBooks. Library is subscribing 1,523 journals which include 1,383 International journals and 140 National Journals and 10,256 back volumes. The Remote Access facilities are available for eJournal packages - IEEE xplore ASPP (189 Journals); Science Direct (345 Journals); Springer (807 Journals); ASCE (39 Journals) and Springer Nature (3 Journals).

It has Open Access System with Online Renewal facility. Its functions are computerized. It also has 54 computers with multimedia and Internet access and a collection of 1,725 CD titles. The Digital Library section has the NPTEL and SVCE video lectures, eBooks, etc. Library has a special collection on 'Books for competitive Examinations' is available as separate section. It has a UPSC Study Circle called 'Dream Big @ SVCE' which helps the students who are interested in preparing for UPSC Examinations. A 'Book Bank' section caters to students belonging to the weaker sections of the community with 1,782 volumes of books. Reading Halls are air-conditioned with Wi-Fi facility. There is a Seminar Hall with state-of-art Video Conferencing facilities.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Facilities are provided for indoor and outdoor games: Swimming pool, a well-equipped gymnasium, a big hall for table tennis, synthetic and clay tennis courts, turf cricket, basketball, football, hand ball, throw ball, ball badminton, volley ball courts and 400 meters track for athletics are the facilities available. Students are encouraged to participate in intramural and extramural activities and Tamil Nadu Inter Engineering Sports (TIES). The College conducts Inter Collegiate tournaments in basketball, volleyball, foot ball, throw ball (women), ball badminton and the Dr A C Muthiah Rolling Trophy in cricket. The multipurpose auditorium provides facilities for playing badminton, basket ball and houses fitness centre for both men and women.

HOSTEL

There are separate hostels with modern amenities for both men and women students. The gents hostel accommodates 850 students whereas the ladies hostel 375 students. The rooms are spacious and well furnished. The residents use the facilities of the college for indoor and outdoor games. Study hours are observed daily. The students can read magazines, newspapers and watch television during free time. They are being taken care of by residential tutors, a residential deputy warden and a residential deputy warden cum nurse. The atmosphere is conducive for the development of overall personality of the students. A spacious mess offers a variety of hygienic and tasty food.

IT INFRASTRUCTURE

SVCE Network consists of local networks within departments and a backbone network that connects the local networks to each other and to networks off campus. The complete campus network is designed and operated by IMS department. The network establishes its data communication to all the academic departments, administrative sections, hostels, staff quarters and to all common buildings. In addition, a well-designed Wi-Fi facility is established throughout the campus for faculty, staff, students, hostel residents and Guests.

A unique separate network is established for CCTV applications that connects the entire campus buildings with the Trust office building located remotely.

ERP software is implemented to cover all the academic and administrative activities and is hosted in Microsoft Azure cloud server.

A well-designed web service is hosted in local server for the purpose of staff, students and for public. The website URL is <https://www.svce.ac.in> For the improvement of Teaching-Learning process, SVCE provides the facility through the on-line supporting tools such as E-Learning facility through ERP, Google G-Suite for Enterprise and campus in-door smart class room facility.

The campus internet service is supported by the TATA Teleservice (P) Ltd and BSNL Internet service providers with the internet bandwidth of 500Mbps and 30Mbps respectively.

COMPUTER NETWORKING AND ONLINE FACILITIES

Nearly 1424 computers of the College are connected using fibre optic back bone. Activities related to Library, Student Attendance, Examination, Academic, Accounts and Establishment are automated. A well designed database of students and staff is also maintained by the Department of Information Management System. All departments have the facility of sending SMS alert to the parents regarding their wards' attendance.

INSURANCE

Our students are covered under the Personal Accident Policy of value Rs. 2,00,000 for each student, taken with 24 hours x 7 days coverage.

FACILITIES IN MEDICAL CENTRE

A medical centre with 6 beds, a resident medical officer and a trained nurse are available in the campus for 24 hrs medical care. The College also has trained staff for immediate medical assistance, ready transport for all emergencies at all time, and first aid boxes available at various places. An ambulance is available round the clock. In addition, there is a separate laboratory for routine investigation, ECG facility and physiotherapy unit which are run by a qualified lab technician

Training and Placement Cell plays a very active role in getting our students placed in various leading multinational and Indian companies. The training and placement activities are looked after by a senior faculty who is assisted by placement coordinators and two student representatives from each discipline. Lines and Auvus Ship management recruit for Marine discipline and several other leading companies have been recruiting year after year.

The Training and Placement Cell (TPC) provides materials for entrance examinations like GATE, GRE, TOEFL through Central library, Department library, Department of HS and others. The Department of HS enhances students' employability skills like personality and communication skills.

Every final year student can opt to go either for higher studies or placement through the college.

Students placed through campus are occupying high level positions in various companies. The TPC also arranges for vocational inplant training to interested students in various companies during their summer and winter vacation.

INDUSTRY INSTITUTE INTERACTION CELL

The Industry Institute Interaction Cell improves the quality of technical education to meet the demands of the industry and bridges the gap between the institute and the industries. It also plays a vital role in creating awareness among students to become entrepreneurs. The following are some of the salient features of the Cell:

- Participation of the experts from industries in curriculum development
- Professional consultancy by the faculty to industries
- Memoranda of Understanding between the institute and industries to bring the two sides emotionally and strategically closer
- Collaborative degree programmes
- Scholarship / fellowships instituted by industries at the institute for students

ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROMOTION & INCUBATION CENTER (EPIC)

An Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) was established in Feb. 2003 with the funding support from National Science and Technology Entrepreneurship Development Board (NSTEDB), Department of Science and Technology (DST) Government of India for a period of five years. On completion of 5 years successfully in Feb, 2008, EDC- SVCE was retained by SVCE Management and the Entrepreneurial activities were continued under various schemes of state and central government on project basis. For the period May, 2011 to May 2014, the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) sanctioned grants to continue the Entrepreneurial activities for the benefit of the student community and science and technology persons in this region.

The Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME) Govt. of India has recognized SVCE to establish a Business Incubator in May, 2015. A dedicated working space of 2,500 sq. ft has been earmarked for business incubation, as an extension of Entrepreneurial activities. The name EDC–SVCE has been renamed as SVCE - EPIC, incubation center of SVCE and it was inaugurated on 2nd Aug 2015

SVCE-EPIC implements entrepreneurship / incubation schemes :

1. **Support for Entrepreneurial and Managerial Development of SMEs through incubation**, Scheme by Ministry of MSME, GOI to create environment and providing hand-holding support for nurturing new business ideas by setting up ten business units over a period of five years.
2. **Entrepreneurship Awareness / development programme** scheme by Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDII) Ahmedabad under the aegis of Department of Science & Technology, Govt. of India.
3. **Developing student entrepreneurs**, The special scheme of Tamilnadu Co-operative Milk Producers' Federation Limited (AAVIN) initiated Entrepreneurship Development and Innovation Institute (EDII-TN) Government of Tamilnadu, SVCE-AAVIN was established in Apr. 2013 and is being operated by 6th batch of student entrepreneurs.
4. **Pre-incubation Service**, a special initiative to Entrepreneurship Promotion & incubation center (SVCE-EPIC) to facilitate SVCE students for converting their innovative idea into a functional prototype by providing financial assistance and technical / business mentorship.

TECHNOLOGY INNOVATION CENTER

This center houses an interdisciplinary center for Nanotechnology to carry out state of art research in the area of Nanotechnology.

In 2017, a shared state-of-the art “Interdisciplinary Centre for Nanotechnology” facility was set up to promote research in the field of nanotechnology. In 2019, the centre was expanded through “Fund for improvement of S&T Infrastructure in Universities and Higher Educational Institutions (FIST) Program - 2018” by the Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of India, Which aims at rebuilding science and Technology infrastructure in the country. DST recognized SVCE as FIST sponsored PG college and the centre was renamed as Interdisplinary Nano Research centre (INRC). The trust areas of the centre include.

- Thin Film technology and microelectronics
- Nanobiotechnology and Tissue Engineering
- Nanocomposites
- Computational Engineering

INSTITUTION INNOVATION COUNCIL (IIC)

MIC intends to create ‘Institution’s Innovation Council (ICCs)’ across selected Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs). A network of these IICs has been established to promote innovation in the Institution through multitudinous modes, leading to an innovation promoting eco-system in the campuses. The major focus of IIC SVCE is to create a vibrant local innovation ecosystem and a start-up supporting mechanism in HEIs, to prepare the institute for Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements Framework, to establish function ecosystem for Scouting and Pre-incubation of ideas, to develop better Cognitive ability for the students.

The various functions of IIC SVCE are to conduct innovation and entrepreneurship-related activities prescribed by Central MIC, to provide opportunity to develop prototypes and nurture new ideas, to perform various experiments with emerging technologies, to identify and reward innovations and share success stories.

Furthermore, IIC SVCE organizes periodic workshops/ seminars/ interactions with entrepreneurs, investors, professionals and create a mentor pool for student innovators, Network with peers and national entrepreneurship development organizations, to Organize Hackathons, idea competition, mini-challenges etc. with the involvement of industries.

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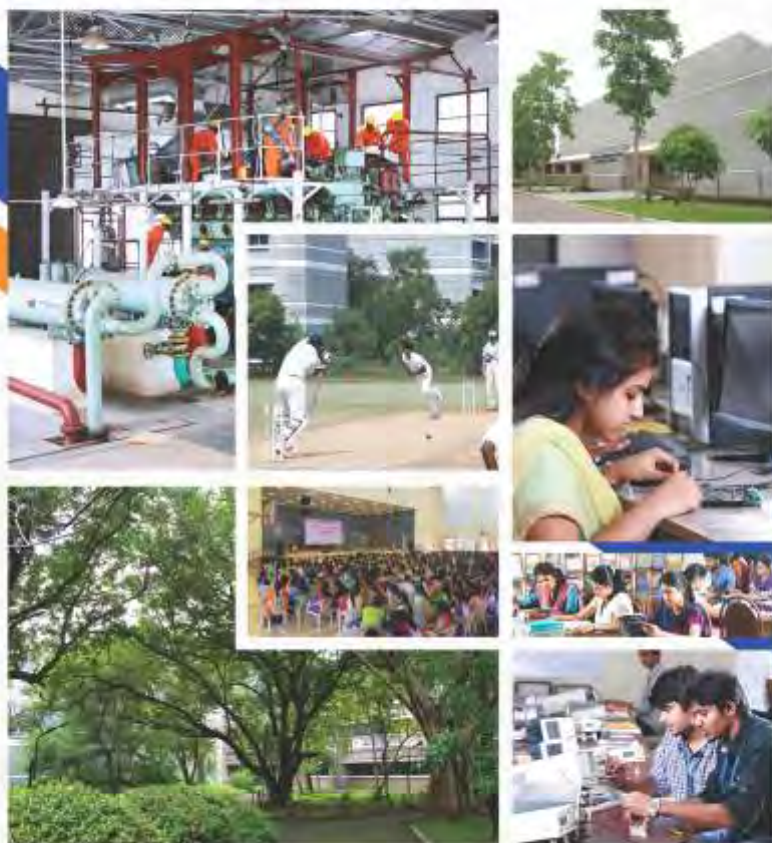
