IQAC coordinator welcomed the principal and all the members gathered for the fourth IQAC quarterly meeting. The Chairperson presented the detailed agenda and facilitated the deliberations.

1) Physical Facilities

HOD/INT and Assistant HOD/INT presented the demo of the data collection software developed by the department and the same was appreciated by the council. Principal suggested adoption of the best practices followed by the department of information technology. HOD/INT informed that the software was developed based on Professional Objective leader's data requirements and extended to cover NAAC and IQAC data requirements.

2) Library as a learning resource

Audio visual centre, E-content development centre, Lecture capturing system and Media centre facilities are available in E-content development facility in Central Library, SVCE.

3) IT infrastructure

CoE has developed an excel sheet based on the 72 Quantitative metrics response and score allotted by the NAAC team from various autonomous colleges. In this excel sheet, CoE entered the response of the 72 Quantitative metrics and analysed the score of each criterion.

4) Maintenance of campus infrastructure

The Estate Maintenance – CIVIL department has responsibility to maintain the campus spread over an extent of 94.38 acres. Building maintenance – Administration, Academic, Hostel and Residential Quarters, Road, Water Supply and Sewage, Housekeeping and Horticulture are the responsibilities taken care by Civil Maintenance. Similarly, Electrical maintenance department has taken responsibility to maintain uninterrupted power supply in the campus. Department of Information Management System has taken responsibility of hosting SVCE website, ERP and purchase of computers hardware and software.

5) Institutional Vision and Leadership

The reputation of our institution is dependent on Program Objectives. So, Chief Placement Officer has to collect the 100% details of the students like placement, higher studies, entrepreneur and dropouts as on date from Department co-ordinators for Placement and Higher studies. All HODs of student departments have to keep the details of last five years students' nominal roll along with their active contact details and their current positions.

6) Strategy Development and Deployment

Dean (Educational Development) has informed that the college is planning to sign a MoU with the institutions abroad in the forthcoming academic year as per the new regulations. Dean (Educational Development) will look into this and the due date for this is before the start of the AY 2022-23.

Mr. N. Reguraj, Member, Governing Council suggested that the college should enhance its relation with the industry by setting up a lab in the college which would attract more students especially in M.E Industrial Automation and Robotics.

HOD/MEC replied on the steps taken towards implementing the PG program with more industry related content.

Principal suggested to visit the NTTF and GD Naidu centre and sign the MoU regarding training the people.

Prof. M.S. Ananth suggested to approach the IITM research park to get help in activity like Incubation and Entrepreneurship Promotion pursued by Dr. S. Illaiyavel, Coordinator –EPIC.

The Departments of Computer Science and Engineering, has successfully renewed their Research centers from Anna University upto December 2024.

7) Faculty Empowerment strategies

CoE requested all the HODs to instruct the faculty member to complete the online evaluation of answer scripts through eMarquer software on or before 10th March 2022.

Research incentive for AY 2018-19 has been approved and 50% for AY 2019-20 has been approved for payment by the management due to the pandemic related financial constraints.

SCM members thanked the Management. From AY 2020-21, performance based research incentive has been revised to include quality of publications rather than numbers. Dr. C. Gopinath, ASP, Department of EEE has filed 2 patents in the name of Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering and the college has paid Rs. 17,800/- to IPR for the same.

Dr. C. Yaashuwanth, Associate Professor, Department of Information Technology, has received a grant of Rs. 17.54 lakhs from ISRO under the scheme RESPOND (JRF) for the research project entitled "Design and Development of Enhanced secured Video Sensor Network". Dr. P.K.Praveen Kumar, Associate Professor, Department of Biotechnology has received a grant of Rs. 8,000/- from DBT under the scheme CTEP to organize Popular Lectures in Biotechnology on "Anti-cancer drug discovery". Dr. P.K.Praveen Kumar (PI), Associate Professor, Department of Biotechnology and Prof. Michael Gromiha M (Mentor), Professor, IITM received Rs. 18,30,000/- for his project titled "Efficacy of HSP90 Mitochondrial targeting of with anolide A and Withaferin A in Hepatocellular carcinoma", under the scheme of Teachers Associateship for Research Excellence (TARE) under DST-SERB, New Delhi.

10) Plan of Action and achievements

Principal congratulated Dr. M. Anandan, Associate Professor/MAR for getting the 2nd place in the one-month refresher course training for NCC officers conducted at the Officers Training Academy, Kampetee, Maharashtra.

Principal informed to create a cell for internship and higher education related activity similar to Placement cell and Higher Education cell.

For the forthcoming academic year, the student intake raised to 120 for the B.Tech (Artificial Intelligence and Data Science) program.

11) Department Evaluation Report (New)

IQAC coordinator informed that there were no non-conformities reported in the 39th Internal Audit which is a positive sign on the standard of our SVCE QMS. Only Opportunity for Improvements (OFI) was reported during the audit and most of them have been corrected.
