The Department of Information Technology hosted Quiz Competition event on "MindMaze" on February 14th, 2024 through the Association of Information Technologists. Students from IT, CSE and AIDS departments enthusiastically joined and competed wholeheartedly.

With a total of 60(44-IT ,6-CSE and 10-AIDS Students) registrations spanning across all academic years, the quiz sought to assess participants understanding not only within academic realms but also beyond. Additionally, it aimed to cultivate teamwork skills, encourage language proficiency, and highlight specific subject domains.

Procedure

• The quiz competition comprised two rounds: an objective question segment conducted through quizzes.com and a rapid-fire round that captivated students for two hours.

- · The initial round consisted of 30 questions designed to evaluate students' proficiency in competitive programming, algorithms, and data structures from every angle.
- · Among the registered participants, 25 students advanced to the subsequent round, which involved a buzzer round.
- · In this phase, 20 questions were posed, assessing students' quick thinking and interaction with their peers.
- · The competition concluded with two participants tied for a score, while the remaining three participants achieved different scores.

Results

Dharun Dharshan from the third year won first prize, with Mohammed Faiz and Parthiban from the second year securing the second and third positions respectively.

Subsequently, Dr. VM Sivagami, Professor of Information Technology and Coordinator of AIT, honored the winners. The first-place recipient received a certificate of appreciation along with Rs. 1000, the second-place winner received Rs. 700, and the third-place recipient was awarded Rs. 500.

Outcomes:

- · Regardless of winning or losing, participants will gain valuable insights and knowledge about data structures and algorithms through the questions asked during the competition.
- · Quiz competitions prompt students to consider various viewpoints, stimulate constructive debates, and bolster language proficiency and targeted academic disciplines.
- Additionally, quiz games serve as an effective icebreakers, encourage competitive learning environments, and boost confidence levels.
