- 5. SRM Institute of Science and Technology.




FLYERS OF THE HACKATHON "EASE THE ERROR 2.0"

Ease The Error 2.0 was a 24 Hour national level hackathon which challenged students to think out-of-the-box and offer innovative ideas to build smart applications which will help address crucial real time problems in our country. The event happened continuously for 24 hours from 15th May to 16th May 2021. It brought together undergraduate students, faculty, staff, and industrial professionals. The hackathon witnessed a participation of a total of 17 teams from all over the state. The developers had to build products that would lay a helping hand in building the future.

The inaugural function was presided over by the honourable chief guest Prof. (Wg Cdr) P.Prabhakar, Chairman BoRIS council, VP IETE India.

The event commenced with a Prayer song by Mr.Sankar Narayanan, member of ISF SVCE, followed by a welcome address by Mr.Vishnusai.R, Honorary Secretary, IETE SF, SVCE. The organizing committee was announced by Ms.Krishnapriya, Executive Member IETE SF SVCE; Mr.S.Saurabh, President FODSE and Mr.Pradeepan, Vice President FODSE. Dr.N.Venkateswaran gave a short note and introduced the chief guest for the day. The chief guest addressed the gathering and prompted them to build products which would benefit the society. Dr.S.Muthukumar, Head of the Department, ECE welcomed the speaker and the participants. Dr.Vidhya, Head of the Department, IT delivered a short note to the gathering. 13. Gaming development






About the judges:


The hackathon consisted of two rounds of judging. The first round of judging began at 6:00 PM on 15th May 2021. The teams were segregated into three different panels. The three judges present for the first round were Mr.Shravan Srinivasan (IV Year–IT), Mr.Padmanaban Alagappan (IV Year-EEE), Mr.Vuppalapatti Chenchu Ujwal (IV Year-ECE). The judges of the preliminary phase examined the work of the participants and made sure their work is abided by the rules and regulations of the event and noted down the progress and also gave suggestions for improvement.

The second round of judging began shortly after the event was over. There were three judges present for second round of judging on 16th May 2021 at 10.30 AM to evaluate the performance of the participants. The judges were enthusiastic with the models and solutions presented and raised question and comments for improvement of the solutions. The solutions were in the form of coding, video demonstration and presentation. The judges were Dr.W.Jino Hans, Associate Proffessor, Department of ECE, SSN College of Engineering, Chennai; Dr.V Sherlin Solomi, Assistant Professor, Department of ECE, Hindustan University, Chennai and Mr.C.Ashok, Assistant Professor, Department of ECE, St.Joseph's College of Engineering, Chennai. All the judges were encouraging and supportive to the participants and appreciated the organizing team for their efforts.
