1. PARTIES

TAYLOR'S UNIVERSITY, an institution of higher learning wholly owned by Taylor's University Sdn. Bhd. (198601000495 /149634-D)/ Taylor's Malaysia Sdn. Bhd. (200501005899 (682946-T), established under the Private Higher Educational Institutions Act 555, which for the purpose of this Agreement is represented by the School of Engineering with address at 1 Jalan Taylor's, 47500 Subang Jaya, Selangor Darul Ehsan, Malaysia (hereinafter referred to as "TU").

And

Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering (Autonomous), Sriperumbudur, Tamil Nadu, India established as per the approval of All India Council for Technical Education (ID: 1-2492131) and affiliated to Anna University, Chennai, with its address at Pennalur, Sriperumbudur, Bangalore Highways Road, Tamilnadu, India (hereinafter referred to as "SVCE").

Individually referred to as Party or Institution and together referred to as Parties or Institutions.

2. PURPOSE

- 2.1 This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) presents the framework for a cooperative relationship between TU and SVCE that aims to develop and foster academic links between the two institutions.
- 2.2 This MOU is not intended to constitute a legally binding contract and does not create any partnership or joint venture or obligate either party to commit financially in any way.
- 2.3 Notwithstanding the non-binding nature of this MOU, each of the Parties acknowledges that it enters into this MOU in good faith and with a high level of commitment towards finding areas of mutual cooperation and collaboration.

3. SCOPE

TU and SVCE have identified and will further explore the following areas for potential bilateral collaboration and cooperation:

- 3.1 Research collaboration
- 3.2 Student and Faculty exchange
- 3.3 Academic exchange (talks, forums, lectures, etc.)
- 3.4 Joint supervision for postgraduate students
- 3.5 Any other initiatives

4. PLANS

Collaborative activities or projects between the parties will be subject to further mutual agreement detailing each party's obligations and responsibilities and the conditions relating to each activity or project and compliance with applicable laws as well as the rules and regulations applicable in each institution.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES

5.1 Coordinator

The Parties agree to designate, on behalf of each institution, a project leader whose responsibility will be to coordinate the execution of this MOU and to draw up a list of programmes or activities to be implemented under this MOU, setting out specific provisions concerning these programmes or activities including budget requirements and details of funding. For this purpose, the contact information of the project leader from each institution is given below:

5.2 Financials

The Parties acknowledge that in the absence of any specific agreement in writing to the contrary, each Party will be responsible for its own costs and expenses in establishing and conducting programmes and activities contemplated under this MOU, including without limitation its own costs and expenses in travel and accommodation.

5.3 Confidentiality

The Parties agree and undertake to keep confidential at all times any information or data that may be exchanged, acquired or shared in connection with any programme or activity conducted pursuant to this MOU save where the same is already in public domain.

5.4 Intellectual Property

Ownership of intellectual property shared by the Parties pursuant to this MOU will remain with the contributor or creator. All such material that must be treated as confidential and not for public circulation specifically agreed by both Parties. This provision is binding on the Parties in writing before exchange of such material/information and will survive the termination or expiry of this MOU.

5.5 Use of Name and Logo

Neither Party may use the name or logo or any variation of the name or logo of the other Party, or of any member of the other Party, or its employees or students, in any publicity, advertising or news release without the prior written approval of an Authorised Representative of that Party.

6. EFFECTIVE DATE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

- 6.1 This MOU shall take effect on and from the date of execution of this MOU and shall continue to be effective for a period of two (2) years and may be extended for such further periods as may be agreed to by the Parties in writing.
- 6.2 Notwithstanding clause 6.1 above, this MOU may be terminated by either Party giving written notice to the other at least three (3) months prior to the proposed date of termination.
- 6.3 Notwithstanding clause 6.2 above, the provisions of this MOU or any other written agreement in respect of any on-going programme or cooperative activity under this MOU shall continue to apply until their completion unless both Parties mutually agree in writing to the earlier termination of the programme or cooperative activity.

7. ANTI-BRIBERY AND CORRUPTION CLAUSE

Each Party represents and warrants that it shall neither take nor refrain from taking any action that could result in liability for the other Party under any anti-corruption or anti-bribery laws and regulations in Malaysia and any other anti-bribery or anti-corruption law or treaty applicable to either Party or, if applicable, its Affiliates. Each Party has and shall maintain in place throughout the Term policies and procedures to confirm compliance with applicable Laws relating to anti-bribery and anti-corruption. Each Party shall promptly report to the other Party any request received by such Party for any undue financial or other advantage of any kind in connection with the performance of this Agreement. Neither Party shall accept, offer or make any payment or provide anything else of value, or take or fail to take any other action which is either prohibited or required by applicable Laws in connection with this Agreement.

Without prejudice to any other express remedies referred to elsewhere in this Agreement or any rights or remedies available at law or in equity, either Party shall have the right to take whatever action it deems appropriate including the right to terminate this Agreement with immediate effect if, acting reasonably, it deems such termination necessary to avoid damage to its reputation or to avoid criminal or other sanctions by the relevant authorities and shall not be liable to pay any compensation to the Party for any loss or damage howsoever arising as a result of the termination under this clause.

EXECUTION AND DATE

Both Parties have caused this Memorandum of Understanding to be executed by their duly authorised representatives.


