

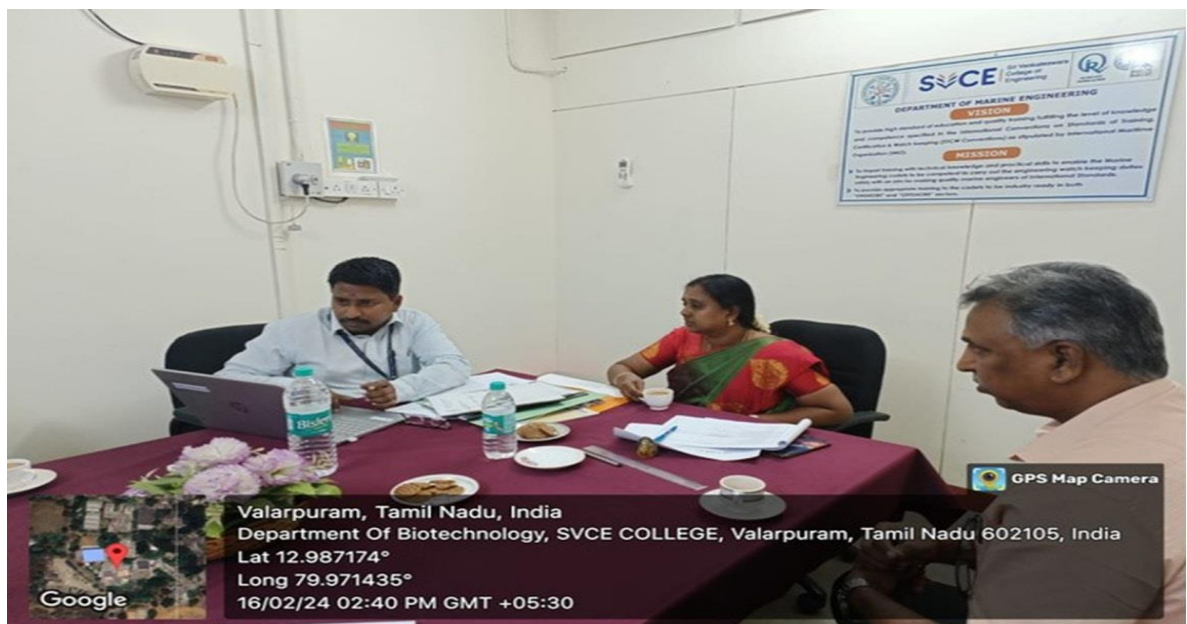
## CIP Inspection :
