
Inauguration


Conducted on 6th August, 2020

Abstraction

Conducted on 29th August, 2020





We conducted our first event, Abstraction 1.0 were more than **100 students** from all departments registered. Various topics ranging from Microprocessors to Neural Networks were the talk of the day.

For the first round, the participants had to illustrate the given topic in simple terms for 3 minutes.

The top 6 who progressed to the final round had 5 minutes each to present pitch decks based on companies such as Uber and Swiggy. The winners of the event grabbed an internship opportunity at **HeyCalibre!**

This event served as a platform where all the participants gained knowledge about various technical buzzwords.

Women in Tech - Webinar

Conducted on 10th September, 2020

A webinar on the topic 'Women in Tech' was conducted by SVCE ACM-W Student Chapter exclusively for women who are looking for a career in tech.

Ms. Prityukshaa Ravi, Senior Consultant at Capgemini, London enlightened us with her vision about the women's workforce, the challenges faced by women, and the various opportunities in the tech field. She also spoke about how to build a personal brand for yourself and what role it plays in terms of your career growth.

Women from all departments attended the webinar which ended with a Q&A session, where the participants got their queries clarified.

The Missing Semester - Workshop

Conducted on 17th & 18th of October, 2020

The Missing Semester was a hands-on workshop conducted by SVCE ACM Student Chapter on the 17th and 18th of October. The participants had a chance to learn about widely used but rarely mentioned tools in the industry. We had a limited number of seats so that the mentors can easily establish a one-to-one session with each participant.

The workshop covered topics such as

- Linux Distros, Shell tools and scripting
- Version Control(Git)
- Metaprogramming
- Containers and Virtual Machines
- Potpouri Topics

The participants attended the 2-day workshop with great enthusiasm. They were divided into 5 groups, each headed by a mentor. On the whole, this workshop enabled students to learn new technologies and brought out the techie inside them.

Rapid Fire

Conducted on 21st November, 2020

Rapid fire was a problem-solving contest conducted by SVCE ACM-W Student Chapter for women from all years and departments of our college. The event consisted of two rounds that aimed at creating a healthy and competitive atmosphere for students to showcase their problem-solving skills.

The preliminary round was an online technical quiz conducted in Kahoot. This round consisted of about 30 questions and the top 20 contenders were shortlisted to participate in the final round.

In the final round, participants had to come up with a technical solution for real-life problems faced by women in society. They had to present their ideas within the time provided to them. This tested their soft skills as well as critical thinking skills.

The winners of the event grabbed internship opportunities at **Prep Junction** in various domains such as - Marketing Research, Business Development, Digital & Content Writing!

December of Algorithms

Conducted for the whole of December, 2020

December of Algorithms is one of the flagship events of SVCE ACM Student Chapter. It was initiated in the year 2018 to allow people to commit to coding regularly, and learn Git in the process.

The goal is for participants to complete 31 algorithms within a span of 31 days. We had participants from all over the world from various backgrounds. The difficulty level of these algorithms ranges from easy to hard, making it possible for everyone to start coding.

In the end, the participants will commit their changes to the Git repository hosted on GitHub and, earn a certificate based on their work.

Conducted on 27th March, 2021

The entrants were split into two categories-beginner and advanced, based on their knowledge in the web design domain. This online submission event received a tremendous response with **200+registrations** from various colleges like IIT's, NIT's, CEG, SSN.

The winners and runners from both categories were awarded cash prizes worth Rs.3k and domain names.

This contest was an excellent approach for the students to combine their creative expression with technology to ace the race of web design over their fellow competitors.
