A 24-hour HACKATHON conducted on 22/03/2024 and 23/03/2024

Make-a-Thon 5.0 was a 24-hour hackathon organized by the Electronics and Communication Engineers Association (ECEA - SVCE) in association with the Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers – Chennai Center and Robotics and Artificial Intelligence Club (RAIC). The event commenced from 22nd March, 2024 at 10:00 AM to 23rd March, 2024 at 10:00 AM (24 hours). Make-a-Thon 5.0 took place at the Multi-purpose Hall at Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering. 



- All the participants from SVCE will be provided with OD's for 22nd March 2024 and 23rd March 2024.


We will require a few basic amenities from the college side:


The following includes

About the Inaugural Ceremony:

INAUGURATION OF MAKE-A-THON 5.0

About the event:

A total of 126 teams registered for the event out of which 37 teams with 4 to 6 members in each team were shortlisted based on the abstract submitted. The preliminary selection was done based on creativity, originality, technology stack, and feasibility. The selection process was carried out by faculty coordinators and student mentors from the Robotics and Artificial Intelligence club. The problem statements for Make-a-Thon 5.0 were aligned with the emerging technologies in the field of engineering.

The domains were:

1. Agriculture and Water Resource Management
2. Authentication and Security- Safety and Security
3. Automation
4. Business and Finance- Sea and Fishery
5. Cultural Heritage and Education
6. Disaster Preparedness – Food and Preservation
7. Health and Lifestyle
8. Healthcare
9. Public Transportation- Sanitation and Waste Management
10. Energy- Environmental Conservation

During the entire event, the mentors and alumni periodically surveyed the progress of all the teams and also provided technical knowledge and mentoring when required. The 37 teams pushed themselves to innovate new models and solutions for their problem statements. Food and refreshments were provided for the participants throughout the event.

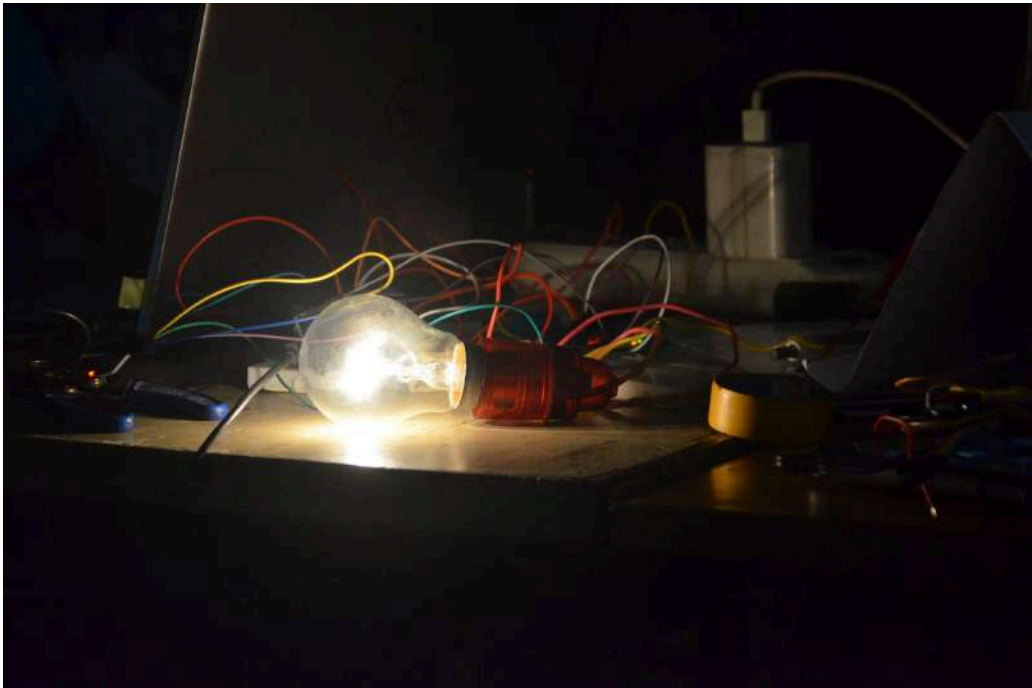
